- There was a discussion between the parents and the Principal for reduction in the proposed 14.68% fee hike. Parents informed that last year approx. 10% hike was already there as books were excluded from last year fees and demanded the justification for such fee hike again and were not convinced with 14.68 % and at last parents requested the fee hike to be brought down to 10% for classes 1 to 10 with all facility same and inclusion of notebooks in this revised fee of 10%.
- The Principal explained to the Exe PTA committee the various factors augmenting expenses and making this hike inevitable. She said that she will propose this to management for this revised fee.
- The parents however were not willing to accept this hike and they signed a resolution proposing a fee hike of **10 %** for the 2 coming years ie 2019-20 & 2020-21 for classes 1 to 10 .This should include the Notebooks to be provided by the school.

For **class 11 and 12 Science stream** they signed for a hike of **3.03%**, offering IP and **9.09%**, offering PE for coming 2 years ie 2019-20 and 2020-21.

For **class 11 and 12 Commerce stream** they signed for a hike of **13.3%** offering IP and **12%** for PE for the coming 2 years ie 2019-20 and 2020-21.

They also signed the proposed fee structure for afternoon batch for class 1-5.

➤ Parents also suggested to reconsider about costly options like Torrins for music. As per their suggestions "School can tie up with some other local cheaper institute for the introductory level and may consider Torrins when students achieve a certain level of expertise. This may help to reduce the expenses by school and may as well reflect in the fees structure."

➤ Parents also suggested to reduce school expenses by not calling famous cricketers and not putting hoardings to advertise it.

➤ The Principal concluded the meeting by reiterating her statement that this reduction in fee hike is very steep and she would not like to compromise the quality of the facilities offered.
